



Dream dormitories

The Lissy Ponies are at home in these magical rooms. With their little beds, they share their dreams and worries as well as lots of magic and fun!



YOU NEED:

- Lissy PONY box (unfolded) • acrylic paints and light pink, pink, purple and light blue • craft paper in pink, pink, purple, light blue and white • wire • bottle and cream lids, painted in your favorite color • 4 shoe boxes
- Also:** • scissors • brushes • craft glue and hot glue

HOW IT WORKS:

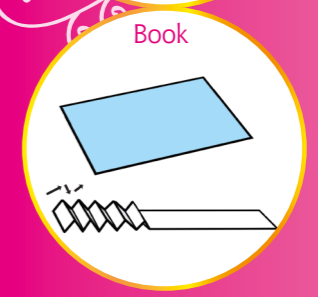
Ask an adult to help you with crafting!




1 Cut through the packaging at the point marked in purple. Cut away everything marked in green. Paint the parts of the box pink.

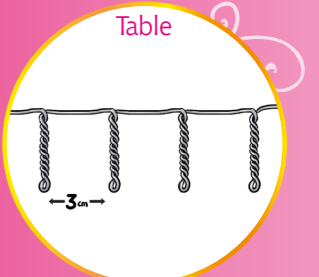


2 Glue the cardboard together to make a shelf. Cut out shelf boards (2 x 7.5 cm) from the remaining cardboard and attach them to the shelf.

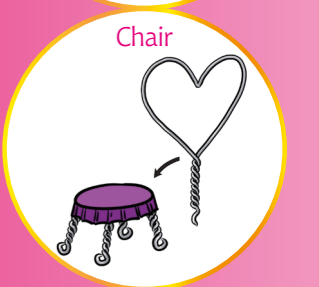


3 Cut out a light blue paper rectangle (5 x 3 cm) and a white paper strip (1.7 x 13.5 cm). Fold the latter like an accordion and glue the ends to the rectangle. Then fold it up like a book.

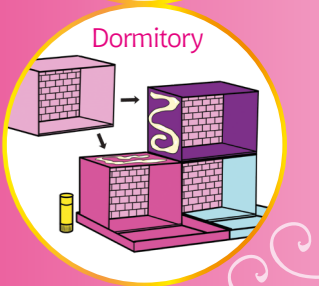
4 From a 40 cm long piece of wire, twist four table legs of the same length, 3 cm apart. Glue them to the inside of the cream lid with hot glue and bend the legs at the bottom.



5 Repeat step 4, but shorten the distance between the wire legs to 2 cm and use a bottle cap as a seat. Form a heart shape out of wire for the backrest.



6 Paint the four shoe boxes in light pink, pink, purple and light blue. Cover the bottom with felt and decorate the large inner wall with the template. Then stack your dormitories and glue them together. Finally, decorate the rooms to your liking!



For the garland, cut out a few paper hearts or other symbols. Glue them to a ribbon at a distance and decorate each dormitory with them.

Cut out stars, crowns, hearts and moons in different sizes from glitter and construction paper. Decorate the walls of your dormitories with them.



Let's play and make some magic together. Let's go!
